Each Adult grade will be split into six divisions, (Young Adult) 18 - 27 (I) 28 – 37 years of age, (II) 38 – 47 years of age, (III) 48 – 57 years of age, (IV) 58 – 67 years of age, and (V) 68+</p> <p>Age categories for Bronze, Silver, Gold and Elite grades are divided up as per NZIFSA Rules &amp; Regulations for Freeskate, Interpretive, Pairs, Solo Dance and Dance events as detailed above.</p> <p><b>Interpretive grades:</b> Adult Interpretive and Youth Interpretive grades shall not be divided by gender.</p> <p><b>CG Adult Entry to Synchro:</b> ( 8 - 16 Skaters) as per the NZISFA Adult Synchro requirements,</p> <p><b>Adult Development requirements:</b> ( 8 - 16 Skaters) Four (4) Mandatory Elements: Intersection Element, Pivot Element - Block, Traveling Element, Linear Element - Line Plus the 5th Element, a CHOICE of one (1) Element from below: Mixed Element, Or Artistic Element – Block, Or Artistic Element – Circle, Or Artistic Element – Line, Or Artistic Element – Wheel</p>
