AMP Scholarship Programme

The AMP Scholarship Programme was established in 1998 and since that time over 70 AMP Scholarships have been awarded to ordinary New Zealanders who are achieving extraordinary things.

Previous recipients range from artists, doctors and scientists, to performers, sports people, entrepreneurs and teachers, and almost everything in between. They all have one thing in common – a determination to turn their dreams into reality.

The AMP Scholarship Programme rewards those with the courage, passion, determination and commitment to achieve their chosen goal no matter what obstacles lie in their path.



The **Scholarship**

This year 12 AMP Scholarships of up to \$10,000 will be awarded. In addition, a further fund of up to \$80,000 will be shared amongst those winners who are selected as AMP Premium winners. Premium winners are selected from the AMP Scholarship recipients.

What activities qualify for support?

There's no limit on qualifying activities or goals.

Whether you're involved in the arts, sciences, sport, music, commerce, industry or community service, all you need is the right attitude and the determination to succeed. You may apply to receive support for a community project, business innovation, course of study, or a sporting, artistic or academic goal. It's entirely up to you!

Who can apply?

Anyone with a vision and the attitude to make it happen can apply for an AMP Scholarship. The only criteria is that you must be either a New Zealand citizen or a permanent resident. Scholarships will only be awarded to individuals.

What are the judges looking for?

Your application will be judged on your ability to demonstrate determination, your aptitude to achieve your chosen goal, and your passion to succeed. While talent will be an important factor, we're looking for individuals with the character and tenacity to succeed against the odds.

Among other things the judges will be looking for:

- Attitude a determined attitude to succeed at your chosen goal
- Willingness and commitment to push personal limits
- Ability to break the mould if necessary to succeed
- **Passion** for your chosen endeavour
- Determination in the face of adverse odds

How do I apply?

To apply for a scholarship go online to www.amp.co.nz and click on AMP Scholarship Programme. You will be asked to select a category.

- Please read the instructions and terms and conditions carefully.
- You will have 20 minutes to complete each section. If you require more time on any one section, just go back to the previous section and your time will begin again.
- Prompts will help you along the way. If you get stuck at any time, click on the HELP button for assistance.
- Your application will be given a unique identification number for your records. Please keep this in a safe place.
- When you are satisfied with your application, print out a copy for yourself, and then click on the SUBMIT button. Your online application will be sent directly through to us.
- Please do not send in any supplementary material, as AMP is unable to return it to you. We will contact you if any additional information is required.

When do applications close?

Applications for the AMP Scholarship Programme open on **1 April 2008** and close at midnight on **30 June 2008**. Winners will be announced in September 2008. All applicants will be notified by email.





Tips for preparing an awesome application

To make it easier for you, and to help you put your best foot forward, we've put together some useful tips for preparing your application. For more useful tips, go to our website www.amp.co.nz

- Be specific about your goal and how you plan to achieve it. For example, if you're applying for support to attend a coaching school, outline how this will help you achieve your overall goal (and tell us what your goal is).
- Summarise your project before providing full details.
- If you're intending to study, tell us where you plan to do this, and give us details about your course. Please make sure you include details of your application status.
- Include details about past achievements, including other scholarships you've received, prizes you've won, or teams you've been selected for.
- Include any information that you think helps demonstrate you have potential, determination and attitude.
- Let your referees know that you're including them in your application and make sure they are happy to be contacted.
- There's no need to include any supplementary material. We will contact you if we require more information.

Remember there is no age limit. We think it takes attitude to achieve goals at any age.
