# 2012 Seminar Calendar

The Officials Director & the Coaching Director have met to work on holding Seminars for officials and coaches in 2012.

These seminars are still being organised and specific notification will be sent once all the details have been worked out.

Although it is not compulsory at the moment it is highly recommended by the Coaching Director that all coaches attend discipline specific seminars if they wish to be accredited in that discipline. This is likely to become a requirement when the next change is made to the Coaches Accreditation Policy.

The seminars are being organised so that everyone attending will get the same information and if they are to be held in different locations, where possible, the same moderator will be used. It is envisaged that the Stroking and Dance Seminars will be held over one weekend with stroking on one day and dance on the other. As the NZIFSA want as many skaters, judges and coaches attending the different seminars as possible the directors are trying to make them easily accessible. There will not be any Level 2 or 3 Coaching Seminars held in 2012. Consideration will be given to holding them in 2013 depending on the number of coaches qualified to attend these.
