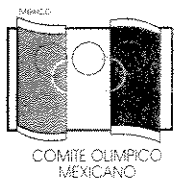

1.- GENERAL REGULATIONS

The competition will be held in accordance to the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2006, the Special Regulations Single Skating 2006 as well as all relevant ISU Communications

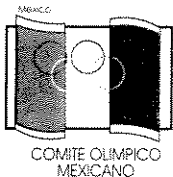
Participation in the Mexican Olympic Festival is open to all skaters who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard the eligibility according to the ISU Constitution and General Regulations Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in the ISU Rule 108, paragraph 2.b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirement in ISU Rule 109 and ISU Communication N° 1420 and any update of this Communication. Entries can only be made through the ISU Member.

REQUERIMENTS:

SINGLES:



An electronic system will be used for the Judging of the competition as well as the ISU – NSJ software with the 2007 – 2008 values and levels of difficulty and characteristics. Therefore, all elements listed on the **ISU Communication N° 1445** may be used in the program, and no other will apply for earning BOV points. All sequences and spins will be used the characteristics and descriptions for the seasons 2007 – 2008 of the same ISU Communication N° 1445 to be evaluated by the technical panel.

Next is a Test level description of those to be included in the competition:



PRE PRELIMINARY (FREE SKATING PROGRAM ONLY – NO SHORT PROGRAM)

Music Time: 1:50 Minutes maximum

Test Level Restrictions: All singles jumps with a BOV (Base of Value) EXCEPT Axels, are permitted in the level, but no jump may repeated more than twice, and the second repetition must be in combo or sequence only.



Next is the list of maximum elements to be included in the program at choice for both men and ladies single events:

- 6 JUMP ELEMENTS- Maximum, from which 3 combos or sequences are possible (two may contain 2 jumps maximum and only one may contain 3 jumps, as In the Senior ISU description).
- 3 SPIN ELEMENTS – to choose from solo spin on one position, flying spin or combo spin without change of foot.
- One Step or Spiral sequence.



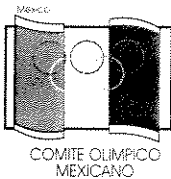
PRELIMINARY (FREE SKATING PROGRAM ONLY – NO SHORT PROGRAM)



Music Time : 2:20 Minutes Maximum

AFILIADO A:

Test Level Restrictions: All singles jumps with a VOB (Base of Value) plus Axels are permitted in this level, but no jump may be repeated more than twice, and the second repetition must be in combo or sequence only.



Next in the list of maximum elements to be included in the program at choice for both men and ladies singles events:

- 6 JUMPS ELEMENTS- Maximum, from which 3 combos or sequence are possible (two may contain 2 jumps maximum and only one may contain 3 jumps, as in the Senior ISU description).
- 3 SPIN ELEMENTS- Of different nature (One solo spin on one position, one flying spin and one combo spin with or without change of foot).
- 1 Step or spiral sequence



INTERMEDIATE 1- SHORT PROGRAM:

- Single Axel
- Single Lutz plus Single Loop Jump Combination
- Jump Combination of two Single Jumps (containing no Axel or Lutz Jump)
- Camel Spin plus Sit Spin Combination (5 revs. Minimum per Position)
- Change Foot Sit Spin (5 Revs. Per Foot Minimum)
- Flying Camel Spin (5 Revs. Minimum)
- Circular Step Sequence

Music Time: 2:20 minutes maximum.

FREE PROGRAM:

Next is the list of maximum elements to be included in the program at choice for both men and ladies single events:

- 6 JUMP ELEMENTS: maximum, from which 3 combos or sequences are possible (two may contain 2 jumps maximum and only one may contain 3 jumps, as on the Senior ISU Description).
- 3 SPIN ELEMENTS: Of different nature (one solo spin on one position, one flying spin and one combo spin with or without change of foot).
- One Step or Spiral Sequence

Test Level Restrictions: Only jumps with a BOV ((base of Value) will count on the Technical Points. No jump included may be repeated more than twice, and the repetition must be in combo or sequence only.

Free Program Time: 2:30 Minutes +- 10 seconds leeway.





INTERMEDIATE 2 SHORT PROGRAM:

- Single Axel
- Double Salchow or Double Toe Loop
- Jump Combination of one Double Jump (different than the above solo double) plus a Single Loop.
- Layback Spin (5 revs. Minimum)
- Change Foot Camel Spin (6 Revs. minimum)
- Flying Sit Spin (5 Revs. Minimum)
- Serpentine Step Sequence

Music Time: 2:20 minutes Maximum



FREE PROGRAM:

Next is the list of maximum elements to be include in the program at choice for both men and ladies singles events.

- 6 JUMP ELEMENTS – Maximum, from which 3 combos or sequences are possible (two may contain 2 jumps maximum and only one may contain 3 jumps, as on the Senior ISU Description).
- 3 SPIN ELEMENTS – Of different nature (one solo spin on one position, one flying spin, and one combo spin with or without change of foot).
- One step or spiral sequence.



Test Level Restrictions: Only jumps with a BOV (Base of Value) will count on technical points. No jumps included may repeat more than twice, and the repetition must be in combo or sequence only.

Free Program Music Time: 2:30 Minutes +- 10 seconds leeway.



INTERMEDIATE 3 (same the elements for Novice), but is for ladies Skaters with more of 15 Years (Born in 1991 or before)



NOVICE, JUNIOR AND SENIOR LEVELS WILL USE THE CURRENT ISU REGULATIONS AND GROUPS FOR THE 2007- 2008 SEASON AND MUSIC TIMES FOR SHORT AND FREE PROGRAMS WILL BE AS DESCRIBED ON THE ISU REGULATIONS.



3.- PARTICIPATION

AFILIADO A:

Each ISU Member may take part with 10 competitors in all categories. Each participating Member has the right to enter one International Judge.



ENTRY FEE: The entry fee for all the individual competitors is \$ 100.00 (One hundred dollars U.S Cy.)

Should there be too many judges nominated for participation, the organizer reserves the right to draw for the composition of panels beforehand and inform those judges who are not draw for service. Only judges, who have participated in one of the ISU Seminar for the ISU Judging System, are eligible to serve in the Mexican Olympic Festival 2007 / 2008.

4.- MUSIC

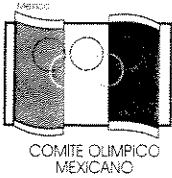
All competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on either cassette, CD, or MD format, in accordance with Rules 343, paragraph 1 and Rule 533, paragraph 1, all cassettes and discus must show the Competition Event, Competitors name, the Nation, the level and the exact running time of the music, (not skating time), including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program (Short and Free) must be recorded on one track and on a separate disc or cassette.

If music information is not complete and cassettes or discs not provided, accreditation will not be given.

All Competitors, Judges, Teams Leaders, Official, Coaches and Chaperons, taking part in the competition are request to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but not later than December 15, 2007, the name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and time of arrival to the "Benito Juarez International Airport" in Mexico City. The official "travel form" should be used.

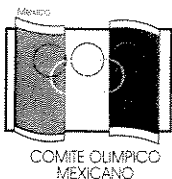

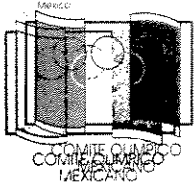
